ORDINANCE NO. 660

AN ORDINANCE CREATING ARTICLE TWO OF CHAPTER XII OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CUNNINGHAM, KANSAS, ENTITLED RECREATION BOARD AND CREATING SECTIONS 12-201, 12-202, 12-203, 12-704, 12-205, 12-206, 12-207, AND 12-208 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CUNNINGHAM, KANSAS, RELATING TO THE CREATION OF THE RECREATION BOARD AS WELL AS THE TERMS OF OFFICE, DUTIES, RECOMMENDATIONS, MEETINGS, ANNUAL REPORTS, BUDGET, AND GIFTS, BEQUESTS, DONATIONS, AND FUNDRAISING OF THE RECREATION BOARD

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CUNNINGHAM, KANSAS:

Section 1: Chapter XII, Article 2 of the Code of the City of Cunningham shall be created and titled "Recreation Board."

Section 2: Section 12-201 of the Code of the City of Cunningham, Kansas, shall be created to read as follows:

"12-201. **RECREATION BOARD; ESTABLISHMENT.** There is established a Recreation Board of this City, which will consist of five (5) members who shall serve without compensation. Those five (5) members shall be resident taxpayers of this City or Kingman County. The members of the Recreation Board shall elect a secretary and a chairperson from its membership each for a term of one (1) year. The members shall also create bylaws and policies for the operation of the Recreation Board and such bylaws and policies shall be approved by the governing body."

Section 3: Section 12-202 of the Code of the City of Cunningham, Kansas, shall be created to read as follows:

"12-202. **SAME; TERMS OF OFFICE.** The Mayor, with the consent of the governing body, shall appoint members to the Recreation Board. Terms of members shall be for three (3) years, but the initial membership terms shall be staggered with three (3) of the first members serving a full three (3) year term, and the remaining first members serving two (2) year terms. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired term."

Section 4: Section 12-203 of the Code of the City of Cunningham, Kansas, shall be created to read as follows:

“12-203. **SAME; DUTIES OF THE BOARD.** The Recreation Board shall make recommendations for the care, improvement, use, and enhancement of the City’s recreational facilities. The Recreation Board shall also coordinate recreational activities for the City as well as coordinate use of the City’s softball fields and sand volleyball courts and any other recreational facility deemed appropriate by the governing body. All recommendations shall be made subject to the approval of the governing body of the City.

Section 5: Section 12-204 of the Code of the City of Cunningham, Kansas, shall be created to read as follows:

“12-204. **SAME; RECOMMENDATION.** The governing body of the City may refer all major proposals and propositions for use of the City’s recreational facilities, new construction, reconstruction, and improvement of the City’s recreational facilities to the Recreation Board. The Recreation Board shall make reports and recommendations to the governing body of all matters referred to it and any further recommendation as deemed advisable.”

Section 6: Section 12-205 of the Code of the City of Cunningham, Kansas, shall be created to read as follows:

“12-205. **SAME; MEETINGS.** The Recreation Board shall meet at least four (4) times per year. Special meetings may also be held if necessary and at such other times as the board may determine. A majority of the members of the board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.”

Section 7: Section 12-206 of the Code of the City of Cunningham, Kansas, shall be created to read as follows:

“12-206. **SAME; ANNUAL REPORTS.** The Recreation Board shall make an annual report of all its proceedings and the condition of the recreational facilities under its coordination to the governing body in the month of January of each year.”

Section 8: Section 12-207 of the Code of the City of Cunningham, Kansas, shall be created to read as follows:

“12-207. **SAME; BUDGET.** On or before the first Monday in June of each year, the Recreation Board shall submit to the governing body a budget of estimated expenditures for the next fiscal year. Thereupon, the governing body shall consider the plans, recommendations, and budget and shall make such allowance therefore as it may deem proper.”

Section 9: Section 12-208 of the Code of the City of Cunningham, Kansas, shall be created to read as follows:


“12-208. **SAME; GIFTS, BEQUESTS, DONATIONS, AND FUNDRAISING.**

- (a) The Recreation Board, by and with the consent of the governing body, may solicit or receive any gifts or bequests of money or other personal property or any donation to be applied, principal or income, to assist the board in carrying out its duties.
- (b) The Recreation Board may also host fund raising events to enhance funding for its projects, subject to approval from the governing body.
- (c) All monies or property received from any source by the Recreation Board or generated through activities of the Recreation Board shall be accounted and submitted to the City Clerk as soon as is practicable after receipt.”


Section 10: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official city paper.
